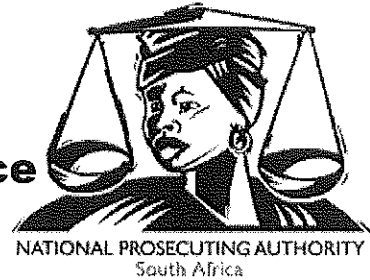

RE: NOTIFICATION OF EVIDENCE SUBMITTED TO AND THE INTERIM FINDINGS OF THE PEOPLE'S TRIBUNAL ON ECONOMIC CRIME

Receipt of your communication with reference: PT/01/OS dated 1 March 2018 incorporating the interim findings of the people's tribunal on economic crime – 7 February 2018 is hereby acknowledged. Despite the communication indicating that the report was sent to the National Director of Public Prosecutions (NDPP), I have established that we have no record of such communication being received in the NDPP's office. I confirm that the communication was forwarded to the NDPP by the office of the Minister of Justice. The NDPP requested me to respond to your communication. From the outset, your attention is drawn to the fact that the annexures marked A, B and C are not attached to the communication. For the sake of completeness, you are kindly requested to furnish same.

The National Prosecuting Authority (NPA) takes note of the contents of your aforementioned communication and the interim findings, which are referred to as the Interim Report. It is further noted that it is mentioned that the Final Report can only be produced at a later stage.

With specific reference to recommendation G of the interim report, it would be appreciated if the mentioned copy of the papers and the summary of the evidence are forwarded to the NPA for the necessary attention.

With regard to the 1999 Arms deal, the Interim Report mentions that the findings of the Seriti Commission are being taken on judicial review, and that the Tribunal may be able to say more about the Arms Deal in more detail if the review proceedings have been concluded by the time they are ready to produce the final report. Whilst any information forwarded to the NPA in the meantime will be attended to, we will await whatever the final outcomes with regard to the Arms Deal, if forwarding same to the NPA will be deemed necessary by the Tribunal.

With regard to State Capture, it is confirmed that there are various investigations currently underway by the Hawks working in tandem with the NPA. It is observed that you have forwarded the evidence that was received by the Tribunal to the Commissioner of Police who will presumably forward same to the Hawks. In addition to the aforementioned investigation, you may be aware that a Commission of Enquiry into State Capture was recently established to investigate the allegations related thereto.
